### APS's RE-OPENING POLL

**Thank you for your patience and ongoing support during this unexpected pandemic. Life as we knew it has certainly been altered. Although there is no set date for when we will re-open, we are working diligently to ensure that when we are able, we can provide you with the best experience possible. We would like to take this opportunity to hear from you as we plan to bring in our new workplace normal.**

2. Everyone will be returning to work on a part time basis. Initially, workers will begin working up to 2-days per week until we establish a normal work routine, and these days may be different than what you worked before.

  - b. Once we go into Green, will there be a caregiver available on days you aren't working? **YES or NO**
3. If your regular transportation company is not available on your scheduled work day(s), do you have an alternate means of transportation to and from work? (Will caregiver or family be willing to bring consumers in to work?)
4. A mask and gloves are required while at work. Are you willing and able to wear both all day, removing them only during break time and lunch time? **YES or NO**

5. There will be daily screening precautions upon returning to work. Having your temperature taken with a *Temporal Artery Thermometer* before entering the building and going on to the work floor is now a requirement to ensure safety of all employees. 6. IMMEDIATE pick-up is **required** in the event that someone has a temperature of 100.4 degrees F/38 degrees C or higher upon arrival. Remaining at work is NOT an option! Should this, or any other health/behavioral emergency occur during the day, it is imperative that we know who to call.
